

**Minutes of the Council  
Meeting  
June 2016**

The following are the minutes of the City Council meeting held on June 7, 2016. In attendance for the Council: Vickie Leinen, Larry Koehne, Jill Diekmann, Steve Wieneke and Mayor Dave Lutmer. Mayor Lutmer called the meeting to order.

On a motion by Steve and seconded by Vickie it was duly passed to approve the Agenda. On a motion by Jill and seconded by Larry it was duly passed to approve the minutes of the Council meeting held on May 10, 2016. On a motion by Jill and seconded by Vickie it was duly passed to approve the financial statement, pay the invoices and make the stated transfers.

On a motion by Steve and seconded by Jill it was duly passed to approve the following persons as election judges for the primary and general elections in 2016: Pearl Wieneke, Jackie Wieneke, Joyce Erdman, Roxanne Kemper, Laura Loosbrock, Mary Sites and Kate McCann as head judge.

On a motion by Larry and seconded by Vickie it was duly passed to approve temporary beer permits to the Lismore Booster Club for Old Home Day on August 6, 2016, St. Anthony Church for the bazaar held on September 11, 2016 and to the Lismore Relief Association fundraiser held on August 20, 2016.

Justin Ahlers gave the maintenance report. Justin reported mosquito spraying will be done tonight, June 7<sup>th</sup>. Street work will probably be started the end of July. There was a large use of water going through the meter last month. There may be a leak in town. The new tractor has been used for mowing. It's working well. The Council addressed concern of the sitting water at the ball field; Justin will work on getting that cleaned up. Several ordinance violations were discussed and letters will be going out to correct the problems. On a motion by Jill and seconded by Larry it was duly passed to approve the maintenance report.

Discussion was held on the Zoning Ordinance in regards to the commercial district. On a motion by Steve and seconded by Vickie it was duly passed to amend Ordinance #71 to set the boundaries along 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to include all existing business and to restrict any further commercial properties to be established.

Clerk's report was given by Kate McCann. Kate reported the election training classes will be held in June. On a motion by Jill and seconded by Larry it was duly passed to approve the clerk's report.
